

Orange County Piano Teachers - Student Policy

Rates

\$30/Half Hour

\$45/One Hour

Students are encouraged to take a one-hour lesson, weekly. Half-hour lessons are available to young children that have trouble maintaining attention through a full, one-hour lesson.

Payment is required in advance and is to be paid during the last lesson of the previous month. Monthly rates are determined by the number of lessons given each month. If there are five lessons in a month, then the charge is for five lessons.

If the student informs the teacher at the beginning of the month that he/she will not be available for certain week of lessons, then he/she will not be charged for that week.

Make-Up Lessons

If for some reason a student is unavailable for a scheduled and paid for lesson, we would appreciate notification at least 24 hours ahead of time. Because a specific time slot is set aside by the instructor for each student, it is the student's responsibility to commit to that given day/time for lessons. Note that time slots are not likely to be filled with another student on last minute cancellation, therefore each rescheduled lesson costs the teacher both time and money. Because of this, we do not reschedule or offer make-up lessons. If a student misses a lesson that he/she has committed to, he/she is still obligated to pay for the lesson.

If a teacher is not available to teach a lesson that the student has already paid for, the teacher is under obligation to either reschedule or give the student credit for the lesson in the following month.

Books and Sheet Music

Books and sheet music are not supplied by the teacher, and will be paid for by the student. The teacher will let the student know what books to use. The teacher will then either, buy the books and require reimbursement from the student, or ask the student to purchase the books. Books are usually around \$10-\$30.
